Ambisafe Respects the Privacy of Our Users

Ambisafe Software Inc. (hereinafter referred as the "Ambisafe", "we", "our" or "us") has developed this Privacy Policy to clearly and transparently communicate what information we collect, as well as how we collect, use, share, store, and protect that information.

BY REGISTERING ON OR SUBMITTING INFORMATION TO THE WEBSITE, YOU SIGNIFY YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THIS PRIVACY POLICY AND CONSENT TO THE DATA PRACTICES PRESCRIBED THEREIN.

Ambisafe proactively encourages each of its Users to engage in privacy best practices. Ambisafe does its best to ensure that everyone who is part of its ecosystem is aware of those practices and has received concrete guidance and/or training concerning implementation. Ambisafe may periodically post changes to this Privacy Policy, and it is the User's responsibility to review this Privacy Policy frequently, and Ambisafe encourages the User to visit this webpage often.

Capitalized terms that are not defined in this Privacy Policy have the meaning given to them in our Terms of Service available at <https://www.ambisafe.com/terms>.

Ambisafe complies with the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of personal information transferred from the European Union to the United States. Ambisafe has certified to the Department of Commerce that it adheres to the Privacy Shield Principles. If there is any conflict between the terms in this Privacy Policy and the Privacy Shield Principles, the Privacy Shield Principles shall govern. Ambisafe is also subject to the investigatory and enforcement powers of the Federal Trade Commission (FTC). Under certain conditions, there is a possibility for you to invoke binding arbitration. For the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield Framework, the Department of Commerce selected the International Centre for Dispute Resolution-American Arbitration Association (ICDR-AAA) to administer the arbitration.

The following are Ambisafe's promises to each User:

(1) **Notice.** When Ambisafe collects your personal information, we give you timely and appropriate notice describing what personal information we are collecting, how we will use it and the types of third parties with whom we may share it. This notice is located in this policy.

(2) **Choice.** Ambisafe will give you choices about the ways we use and share your personal information, and we will respect the choices you make.

(3) **Relevance.** Ambisafe will collect only as much personal information as is required to meet the specific, identified purposes of the Transaction it is effectuating, and we will not use it for other purposes without obtaining your consent.

(4) **Retention.** Ambisafe will keep your personal information only as long as we need it for the purposes for which we collect it, or as permitted by law.

(5) **Accuracy.** Ambisafe will take appropriate steps to make sure your personal information in our records is accurate, as much as is within the power of Ambisafe.

(6) **Access.** Ambisafe will provide ways for you to access your personal information as quickly as possible upon request, as required by law, so you can correct inaccuracies. Please use the address below to request access to your information.

(7) **Security.** Ambisafe will take appropriate physical, technical and organizational measures to protect your personal information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, alteration, and destruction. Ambisafe uses the highest industry standards with respect to storage of data and the security of its system.

(8) **Sharing.** Except as described herein, Ambisafe will not share your personal information with third parties without your consent.

(9) **International Transfer.** If Ambisafe is used to transfer your personal information to another country, Ambisafe will take appropriate measures to protect your privacy and the personal information transferred.

(10) **Enforcement.** Ambisafe will regularly review how we are meeting these privacy promises, and we provide an independent way to resolve complaints about our privacy practices (see immediately below).

TYPE OF INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND HOW WE COLLECT INFORMATION

Your Identifiable Information.

Through this Website, we may collect information that can identify you (“Identifiable Information”) when it is voluntarily submitted to us through the Ambisafe Website. This policy applies to any means of information submission.

Your Identifiable Information includes:

- Your name;
- Your company's name;
- Your email address;
- Your company's size;
- Your company's website;
- Your title at the company;
- Date of birth;
- Current address or principal place of business, including country of residence;
- Identification number, including, but not limited to social security number, tax identification number and/or passport;
- Government-Issued Identification or other government issued documents proving existence of a legal entity;
- Credit card information; and
- Other similar information.

Upon registration, you are prompted for the following information:

- Your name (first and last);
- Your company's name;
- Your company's size;
- Your title at the company;
- Your company's website URL;
- Your email address;
- Your city, state, and country of residence; and
- A password that you create for login purposes.

If your Country of Residence is not a Restricted Location, as defined in Ambisafe's Terms of Service, Ambisafe will use this information to immediately email you an activation link. By entering all of the above information, you consent to Ambisafe sending you an Account activation link via email at the email address you provided at sign up. Ambisafe uses SendGrid and Postmark, third-party providers, and discloses your email address in order complete the email authentication process. Please see SendGrid's privacy policy available at <https://sendgrid.com/policies/privacy/> and Postmark's privacy policy available at <https://postmarkapp.com> to learn about how they collect your information, store your information, and protect your information.

You further consent to receiving other communications related to your use of Ambisafe. After the activation is complete, Ambisafe may require you to provide:

- Your date of birth;
- Your address or principal place of business;

- A government issued identification number, such as a social security number, tax identification number or passport number; and
- A government-issued identification document evidencing your nationality or residence and bearing a photograph, such as a driver's license or passport, or if you are an entity, other documents proving the existence of a legal entity, such as certified articles of incorporation, a government-issued business license, a partnership agreement, or trust agreement.

Ambisafe will verify the information you provided using third-party verification providers, including, but not limited to Onfido. Please review Onfido's privacy policy available at <https://onfido.com/privacy> to learn about how Onfido collects, stores, and protects your information. Additionally, we provide your credit card information to our third-party payment service provider Stripe. Stripe collects, stores, and processes your credit card information and other payment information on our behalf using industry-standard security measures. Ambisafe does not store your credit card information.

Usage Information.

We may also collect certain types of usage information when you visit our Website, or use our Services, such as information about your device and its software, including, but not limited to the User's:

- IP Address;
- Browser Type;
- Internet service provider;
- Platform type;
- Device identifier;
- Device type and manufacturer;
- Operating system;
- Browser settings;
- Language preference;
- Browser version;
- Location information;
- Other device settings;
- Previous webpage visited;
- Length of visit and usage;
- Navigate of Website;
- Number of clicks;
- Frequency of clicks and visits;
- Date and time stamps of activity on the Website; and
- Any other technological usage information.

Ambisafe may use third-party providers to collect the Usage Information, including, but not limited to Google Analytics. Additionally, when you use Ambisafe Services, we may collect

information about your Transaction and/or other activities on our Website for fraud prevention purposes, to monitor for possible breaches of the User's Account, and to identify any malicious software or other activity that may harm Ambisafe or its Users. We may also collect data about your use of our Website or Services, from which personal information has been removed.

We or our third-party partners may also use cookies, web beacons, or other technologies to collect and store other information about your visit to, or use of our Services, including, but not limited to, your duration or specific links you click on. We may later associate the usage and other information we collect online with personal information about you.

Further, any information a User discloses to Ambisafe's Support may be collected. If you encounter a crash or error while using our Services, we may generate a crash report that includes technical, usage, and if you are logged in, Account information so that we can diagnose and potentially prevent the problem in the future. Ambisafe uses third-party tools to collect this information.

We may ask your permission before collecting certain information, such as precise geo-location information.

Non-Identifiable Information.

We may also automatically collect other non-identifiable information in connection with your visit to this Website ("Non-Identifiable Information").

HOW WE USE COOKIES

Ambisafe, or our services providers and other companies we work with, may deploy and use cookies, web beacons, local shared objects, and other tracking technologies to track your use of the Website and the Services, or for various other purposes, such as fraud prevention and monitoring, as well as advertising and marketing performance. These tools may detect characteristics or settings of the specific device you use to access our Website or Services. We may also collect information, such as the types of Services used and the number of users our Website or Services receive daily. Our servers automatically log information about your computer, but we do not use this information to identify you personally.

Cookies are small amounts of data a website can send to a visitor's web browser. They function as your computer's identification card and enables Ambisafe to improve your experience by securely maintaining your authenticated session and preferences. Cookies may also enable us or our service providers and other companies we work with to relate your use of our Services over time to customize your experience.

A web beacon embeds a small transparent gif image in a webpage or email, and is used to help recognize users, identify when users access the webpage or view the email, assess traffic patterns

and measure website engagement. Local shared objects may be stored on your hard drive using a media player or other software installed on your device. Local shared objects are similar to cookies in terms of their option, but may not be managed in your browser the same way and may not function as an identification card nor store any data on your device.

Most Internet browsers are set up to accept cookies automatically. You can set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, allowing you to decide whether or not to accept it. For some web pages requiring an authorization, cookies are not optional. Users choosing not to accept cookies or similar devices may not be able to access those webpages or the Services.

HOW WE USE THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Primary Purposes.

Ambisafe's primary purpose in collecting the information is to provide you with a secure and efficient experience. Ambisafe may use the information for the following purposes:

- Allow Users to create and operate an Account;
- Verify a User's identity;
- Provide Ambisafe Services;
- Process Transactions and send notices about your Transactions;
- Resolve disputes, collect fees, and troubleshoot problems;
- Prevent and investigate potentially prohibited or illegal activities, and/or violations of our posted Terms of Service;
- Generate statistics about how the Services are being used;
- Perform analytics concerning your use of the Services;
- Target advertising and communications;
- Deliver targeted marketing and promotional offers; and
- To meet any legal or regulatory requirements.

Ambisafe may also use data that we collect on an anonymous basis, such that it does not identify any individual customer, for various business purposes, where permissible under applicable laws and regulations. Such data is used to help us understand consumer trends, needs, interests, and preferences so we can improve our Services.

Interacting With You.

We will use your Identifiable Information to communicate with you, manage your Account, respond to requests or complaints you may make of us and for the sole purpose of your participation at the Ambisafe Website.

Making Our Platform Better.

From time to time, we may refer to your Identifiable Information to better understand your needs and how we can improve and develop our Services. We may also refer to Non-Identifiable Information to analyze the performance of, and make improvements to, our platform. We do not sell your Identifiable Information to any third parties.

WHEN WE DISCLOSE YOUR INFORMATION TO OTHERS

Except to the extent required by applicable law or governmental or judicial body, Ambisafe will not disclose your Identifiable Information to any third party other than to a regulator, our affiliates, a third-party service provider, a third-party verification provider, a partner, a vendor, an affiliated third-party, or representative to whom we are required to disclose such information to in order for them to assist us in providing our Services to you.

Ambisafe uses third-party providers, including, but not limited to Postmark or SendGrid, to effectuate any transactional emails. Please see Postmark's and SendGrid's privacy policies, available at <https://postmarkapp.com> and <https://sendgrid.com/policies/privacy/>, respectfully, in order to learn about how they collect, store, and protect your information. Ambisafe may also disclose your email address to third party providers that perform marketing services on Ambisafe's behalf. Specifically, Ambisafe uses MailChimp, a third-party service provider, and discloses your email address to MailChimp in order to send you marketing emails about Ambisafe. Please see MailChimp's privacy policy, available at <https://mailchimp.com/legal/privacy/>, to learn more about how they collect, store, and protect your information.

Ambisafe may use third-party providers to perform Anti-Money Laundering (AML) checks and to perform verification procedures, also known as "Know Your Customer" (KYC), in order to comply with KYC and AML Requirements. By providing your credit card information or other payment information, you consent to Ambisafe disclosing your credit card information or other payment information to a third-party payment service provider, including, but not limited to, Stripe. Stripe will collect, store, and process the credit card information or other payment information on behalf of Ambisafe.

We may share your Identifiable Information to comply with requests by law enforcement or governmental authorities, or where we have any other legal obligation to disclose the information sought. Your information may be disclosed or transferred as part of, or during negotiations of, a merger, consolidation, sale of our assets, as well as equity financing, acquisition, strategic alliance, or in any other situations where such information may be transferred as one of the business assets of Ambisafe.

To achieve the purposes described herein, Ambisafe employs the services of individuals and companies, such as those described above, to perform tasks on our behalf. However, our agents and those third-parties noted above, do not have any right to use your Identifiable Information we share with them beyond what is necessary to assist us in providing the Services to you as described in this Privacy Policy. Any third-party which receives or has access to your Identifiable

Information shall be required by us to protect such information and to use it only to carry out the services they are performing for you or for Ambisafe, unless otherwise required or permitted by law.

Ambisafe may also share or disclose your information with your consent or under your direction to do so.

MARKETING AND PROMOTIONAL COMMUNICATION

If you wish to receive our targeted and relevant promotional communication, we offer you the option to “opt-in” to this service. If you change your mind and wish to stop receiving any such communication, you may opt out of receiving promotional communication from Ambisafe by following the instructions in those communications.

We may share your email address with third-party providers to perform marketing services on Ambisafe’s behalf and display ads that may be relevant to your interests. However, you have the right to ask us not to process your information for marketing purposes. You can exercise this right and limit this by contacting us at support@ambisafe.com.

HOW WE STORE INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Ambisafe will take reasonable precautions, as well as physical, technical, and organizational measures in accordance with industry standards, as described herein, to protect your Identifiable Information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. Information you provide is transmitted to and stored by Ambisafe using industry-standard methods for each type of information.

The Ambisafe Services are maintained in the United States of America and all servers, which store your Identifiable Information, are secured and located in the United States of America. We use computer safeguards, such as firewalls and data encryption. We authorize access to your information only for those employees who require it to fulfill their job responsibilities and these employees are required to treat this information as confidential.

However, Ambisafe cannot guarantee the security of information on or transmitted via the Internet. Any transmission is at your own risk as the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Users are solely responsible for protecting their passwords, limiting access to their computers, and signing out of Ambisafe after their sessions.

Although Ambisafe has Users from all over the world, by accessing the Services, the User consents to and authorizes the export of their Identifiable Information to the United States and its storage and use as specified in the Privacy Policy.

Ambisafe will retain your information for as long as your Account is active or is needed to provide you Ambisafe Services, having regard to the purposes described in the Privacy Policy, and our own legal and regulatory requirements. Ambisafe will retain Accounts and Identifiable Information for, at least a period of five years after they are closed by Users, or as necessary to comply with our legal obligations or to resolve disputes.

The security measures in place will, from time to time, be reviewed in line with legal and technical developments.

HOW TO ACCESS, UPDATE & DELETE YOUR INFORMATION

The User has the right to review, correct, update, or amend the Identifiable Information where it is inaccurate, and the User may do so at any time by sending a request to the address listed below. The User is also entitled to request the deletion or destruction of both the Account and Identifiable Information by sending a request to the address listed below. In your request, be as detailed as possible about what you want Ambisafe to do with your information. Additionally, you may request a copy of the information we have collected about you by contacting us with your full name and email address. Please send all requests to the following address:

While we strive to honor all reasonable requests, please be aware that we backup our data to prevent accidental or malicious destruction of your information. Information on backup servers may take some time to be completely deleted from our system. If you request that we remove you from our system, please note that you may still receive materials from us while your request is being processed.

If you request that your Account be deleted, we will keep your Account information for a period of time in order to deter fraud, by ensuring that persons who try to commit fraud will not be able to avoid detection simply by closing their Account and opening a new Account. However, if you delete your Account, your Identifiable Information will not be used by Ambisafe for any further purposes, nor sold or shared with third parties, except as necessary to prevent fraud and assist law enforcement, as required by law, or in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

LINKS TO OTHER WEBSITES

The Ambisafe Services may contain links to other websites not operated or controlled by Ambisafe. This Privacy Policy only applies to the Ambisafe Website and Services. Ambisafe is not responsible for the content, accuracy, or opinions expressed in other websites, and such websites are not investigated, monitored, or checked for accuracy or completeness by Ambisafe. Please note that when you use a link to go from the Ambisafe Services to another website, our

Privacy Policy is no longer in effect. Ambisafe encourages you to review all policies, rules, terms and regulations, including the privacy policy, of each website that you visit.

NOTICE CONCERNING CHILDREN'S INFORMATION

Ambisafe does not direct any of its business practices or system outputs directly or indirectly towards children. We are committed to respecting the privacy of children online and ensuring that Ambisafe is compliant with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA). If Ambisafe learns that the information of a child under the age of thirteen (13) is stored within its platform, Ambisafe will promptly delete any Identifiable Information in that User's Account or any other profile information that Ambisafe has been used for.

UPDATES TO THIS POLICY

We reserve the right to change, modify, update, add, or remove portions of this Privacy Policy at any time. Any changes or updates will be effective immediately upon posting to this page. When we do update it, for your convenience, we will make the updated policy available on this page. Ambisafe encourages all Users to check this Website Privacy Policy frequently to stay up to date on any changes. You can determine if changes have been made by checking the effective date on the Privacy Policy. Continued use of the Website after the effective date of any change in this Privacy Policy will constitute acceptance of such changes.

AMBISAFE'S POLICY FOR DATA TRANSFER FROM THE EUROPEAN UNION

Some of our Users' use of the Ambisafe system may require a cross-border transfer of personal information. Ambisafe is already committed to adhering to the principles of Notice, Choice, Accountability for Onward Transfer, Security, Data Integrity and Purpose Limitation, Access, and Recourse, Enforcement, and Liability in accordance with the requirements of the laws of the European Union.

Definitions

"Personal Information" or "Information" means any information or set of information that (1) is transferred from the EU to another country; (2) is recorded in any form or medium; (3) is about, or pertains to a specific individual; and (4) that identifies, or can be used to identify, a specific individual.

"Sensitive Personal Information" means Personal Information that reveals race, ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, or information that concerns health or sex life. In this Privacy Policy, all references to Personal Information include Sensitive Personal Information.

Principles

Notice. Ambisafe shall inform an individual of the purpose for which it collects and uses the Personal Information and the types of third parties to which Ambisafe discloses or may disclose that Information. Ambisafe shall provide the individual with the choice and means for limiting the use and disclosure of their Personal Information. Notice will be provided in clear and conspicuous language when individuals are first asked to provide Personal Information to Ambisafe, or as soon as practicable thereafter, and in any event before Ambisafe uses or discloses the Information for a purpose other than for which it was originally collected. Such notice may be disseminated, for example, through the provision of this Privacy Policy.

The types of Personal Information that Ambisafe may collect in order to provide Services to our Users include, but are not limited to, the first and last names, email address, date of birth, current address or principal place of business, passwords created at registration on Ambisafe, and phone numbers.

We collect Personal Information for various purposes, which include, but are not limited to, your specific use of the Ambisafe Services.

Choice. Ambisafe will offer individuals the opportunity to choose (opt in or out) of whether their Personal Information is (1) to be disclosed to a third party, or (2) to be used for a purpose other than the purpose for which it was originally collected or subsequently authorized by the individual. We will comply with the requirements of the laws of the European Union with respect to disclosures of Sensitive Personal Information, including, when applicable, obtaining the explicit consent (i.e., opt in consent) of the individual prior to disclosing sensitive information to a third

party or using Sensitive Personal Information for purposes other than those for which it was originally collected or subsequently authorized by the individual. Ambisafe shall treat Sensitive Personal Information received from an individual the same as the individual would treat and identify it as Sensitive Personal Information.

Accountability for Onward Transfers to Third Parties. Ambisafe is potentially liable in cases of onward transfers of Personal Information to third parties. Prior to disclosing Personal Information to a third party, Ambisafe shall notify the individual of such disclosure and allow the individual the choice (opt-out) of such disclosure. As stated above, prior to disclosing Sensitive Personal Information to a third party, Ambisafe, in most instances, will obtain the individual's affirmative express (opt in) consent. Ambisafe shall ensure that any third party to which Personal Information may be disclosed subscribes to the Principles or are subject to law and/or agreements providing the same level of privacy protection as is required by the Principles, and agree in writing to provide an adequate level of privacy protection. We may transfer Personal Information to third-party agents, or service providers, who perform functions on our behalf. We enter into written agreements with those third-party agents and service providers requiring them to provide the same level of protection that the laws of the European Union require and limiting their use of the data to the specified services provided on our behalf.

At this time, we do not transfer Personal Information to unaffiliated third parties acting as data controllers. If we choose to begin transferring your Personal Information to such third parties, we will notify you by updating this Privacy Policy.

In some rare cases, it may be necessary to disclose Personal Information in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements.

Data Security. Ambisafe shall take reasonable steps to protect the Information from loss, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. Ambisafe has put in place appropriate physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the Information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, alteration or destruction. Ambisafe has a continued commitment to create and maintain the most stringent controls needed to ensure the highest quality and security of services provided to its Users. Ambisafe cannot guarantee the security of Information on or transmitted via the Internet.

Data Integrity. Ambisafe shall only process Personal Information in a way that is compatible with and relevant to the purposes for which it was collected or authorized by the individual. To the extent necessary for this purpose, Ambisafe shall take reasonable steps to ensure that Personal Information is accurate, complete, current and reliable for its intended use.

Access. An individual has the right to obtain Ambisafe's confirmation as to whether we maintain Personal Information relating to you. Upon request, Ambisafe shall allow an individual access to his or her Personal Information and allow the individual to correct, amend or delete inaccurate information. An individual's right to access Personal Information may be restricted in exceptional

circumstances, including, but not limited to, when the burden or expense of providing access would be disproportionate to the risks to the privacy of the individual in the case in question or where the rights of persons other than the individual may be violated. If Ambisafe determines that an individual's access should be restricted in a particular instance, Ambisafe will provide the individual with an explanation of the determination and respond to any inquiries the individual may have.

To request to access, correct, or amend Personal Information, an individual may contact Ambisafe's Privacy Compliance at the contact information provided below.

Recourse, Enforcement, and Liability. Ambisafe uses a self-assessment approach to assure compliance with this Privacy Policy and periodically verifies that the policy is accurate, comprehensive for the information intended to be covered, prominently displayed, completely implemented and accessible and in conformity with the requirements of the laws of the European Union. We encourage interested persons to raise any concerns or complaints using the contact information provided below, and we will investigate and attempt to resolve any complaints and disputes regarding use and disclosure of Personal Information. If a complaint or dispute cannot be resolved through our internal process, we agree to dispute resolution using the European Data Protection Authorities (EU DPAs) as an independent recourse mechanism. Ambisafe will cooperate with the DPAs in the investigation and resolution of complaints brought by you. Ambisafe agrees to comply with any advice given by the DPAs where the DPAs take the view that the organization needs to take specific action.

Amendments

This Privacy Policy may be amended from time to time consistent with the requirements of the laws of the European Union. Ambisafe will provide notification of such changes through the Ambisafe Website.
